Faculty of Health Undergraduate Summer Research Awards (USRA)

The Faculty of Health annually provides internally funded USRAs to enable students to experience research within the Faculty. One USRA is funded through NSERC and is therefore awarded to NSERC-related research,¹ while the remainder are open to any area of research. When such students apply, at least two USRAs will be awarded to applicants from under-represented groups². The Faculty of Health partners with Imhotep's Legacy Academy (ILA) to offer an additional summer student research scholarship (SSRS) for applicants identifying as people of African descent.³ Interested applicants' files will be forwarded by the Faculty of Health to ILA for consideration. All awards (USRAs & SSRS) are valued at \$9,400. Questions about this application form or competition may be directed to fohr@dal.ca.

USRA application materials are reviewed by a panel comprising of faculty from the Faculty of Health who consider past academic performance, research experience and research potential in determining successful applicants. SSRS application materials are reviewed by the ILA's Board of Directors, the Faculty of Health Associate Dean – Research, and the African Nova Scotian Health Sciences Initiative Committee.

Eligibility ([click here](#) for detailed NSERC USRA eligibility)

- You are a student enrolled in a Faculty of Health undergraduate program working with a supervisor in the Faculty of Health
- You are a student enrolled in an undergraduate program in another Faculty at Dalhousie working with a supervisor in the Faculty of Health
- You are a student enrolled in a Faculty of Health undergraduate program working with a supervisor in another Faculty at Dalhousie
- Available to work fulltime for 16 weeks (May-August)⁴
- You are not currently receiving another summer research award (USRAs cannot be stacked with other awards)
- International students are encouraged to apply for a summer research award. While not eligible for NSERC USRAs, they are considered for all other USRAs
- For NSERC USRAs, you have not previously held the award 3 times in your undergraduate degree
- Have completed all the course requirements of at least the first year of study (or two academic terms) and have not earned any research-based graduate degrees (e.g., Masters or PhD)

NOTE: Applications where the research is based in the Faculty of Health will be prioritized. While awarded to a student, supervisors are capped at 2 FH USRAs per year.
